Wienwork is a non-profit limited company with a strong social mission

- Employment, training, counseling, and qualifications for people with disabilities and long-term unemployed individuals
- Established in 1981 as "Protected Workshops for Vienna"
- Around 70% of our adult employees and all 180 apprentices have a disability
- Our work is guided by the Austrian Act on the Employment of People with Disabilities



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Our Core Principles

- Salaries are based on collective agreements
- Inclusive Employment: Matching jobs with each person's abilities
- Main goal: Participation in our society and securing one's livelihood
- Human Resources Development is based on continuous training and education tailored to job roles
- Workplace Health Promotion

Inclusive Apprenticeship

We offer training in 11 professions for 180 apprentices:

- Retail Salesperson
- Bricklayer
- Cook
- Pastry chef
- Landscape Gardener
- Painter & Coating Technician
- Tiler and Paver
- Cleaning Technician
- Waiter/waitress
- Carpenter
- Dry Cleaning Operative (laundry)



Extended Apprenticeship & Partial Qualification

- for young people aged 15-25 years with (multiple) disabilities
- Integrated Training combines hands-on experience at WienWork and partner organizations over 3–4 years
- Multi-professional Teams: Trainers, educators,
 communication assistants (for the deaf), psychological
 counselors, social workers, and job placement support.
- Additional Programms: ERASMUS+ (training abroad within the European Union); Summer & Sports-week

Success Rate: ~85% of apprentices pass their final exams; ~50% transition into the open labor market.



→ We offer Supported Employment & Coaching for both young people and adults.



Programs for adults

- Supported Employment Counselling for adults with disabilities
- Jobcoaching Support when employment becomes unstable
- "Founding-counselling" Assistance with job reentry or self-employment (e.g., tobacco shops)
- Betriebsservice support & counselling for entrepreneurs/organizations
- "QualiTRAIN" Job qualification for adults with disabilities – for adults with disabilities





Programs for Young People

- Ausbildungsfit Flanke Wien
 - One-year motivational program for youth with and without disabilities. Aim: to get job ready, start an apprenticeship, work, further education
- "On the Job"

Three-year program for young people with disabilities Aim: start an apprenticeship, further training course

- Youth-Coaching
 Counseling for students finishing compulsory education (~14–15 years)
- Supported Employment for young people
 Support in starting apprenticeships, jobs, or further education
- <u>SzenenWelten</u>

Bringing young people back into education; includes parents, dance- & theater workshops, and psychotherapeutic support
