Recommendations:

- We need to find / use interactive ways, so that sharing or learning is inspiring, i.e. avoid a typical webinar where you only have long presentations and QA session
- Assure that users and professionals have modern technology that enables access
- Competence development (incl. learning mobility related areas and digital tools, teleworking etc.) of guidance professionals is the key prioritize
